Richland One offers full-day, free Prekindergarten with certified teachers for 3 and 4-year-olds. The program is voluntary, and space is limited!

3K (3-Year-Olds)

- Child must be 3 years old by September 1, 2022
- Only offered at Gadsden Elementary
- Open to Richland One families able to provide transportation

4K (4-Year-Olds)

- Child must be 4 years old by September 1, 2022
- Offered through your child's zoned school

Special Services

If you have concerns about your child's learning or development, they may qualify for special services through Richland One. Pre-K Special services are available to children ages 3 through 5 years. To register your child for traditional 3K or 4K through Richland One:

- 1) Watch the Parent Information Session and complete the survey
- Complete the <u>Prek Application</u> online (Open Dec. 13)
- 3) Complete the <u>New Student</u> <u>Registration</u> online (Open Dec. 13)
- 4) Submit required documents to the Office of School Readiness (via email or drop off):
 - a. Birth Certificate
 - b. Proof of Income
- 5) Take acceptance letter and the following documents to zoned school:
 - a. Immunization
 - b. Proof of Residence (mortgage/ lease and utility bill)
 - c. Shared Housing (if applicable)
